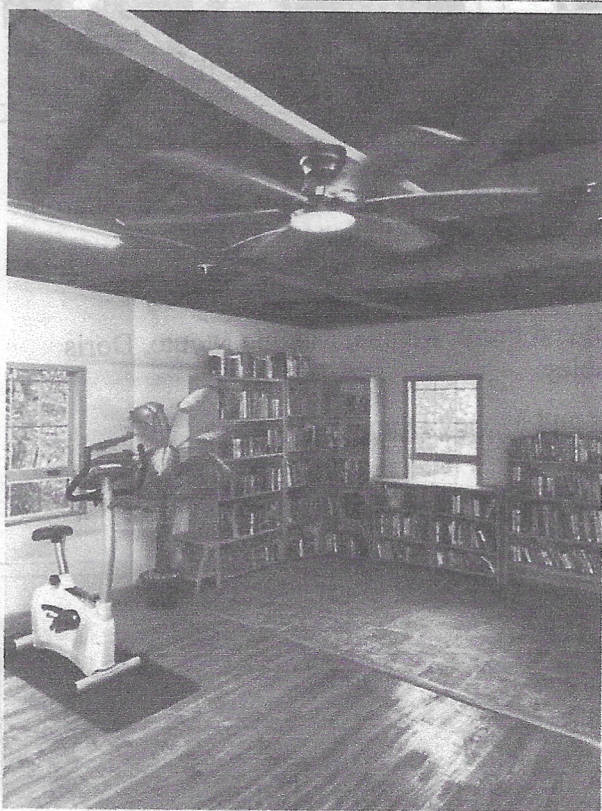

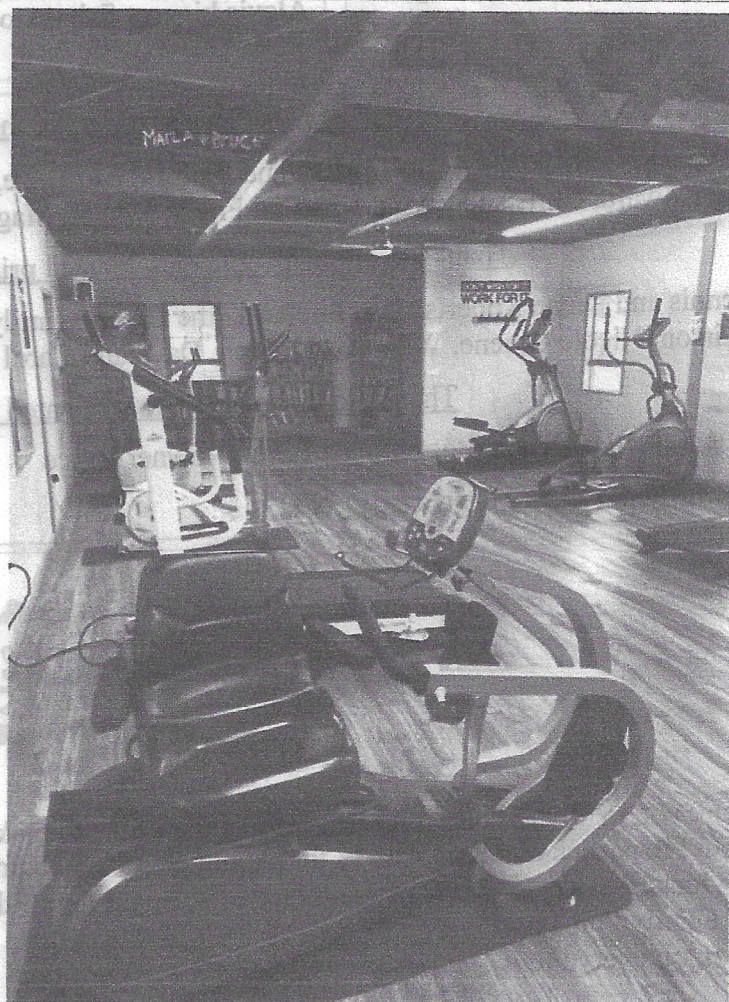

Thanks to everyone who donated their time, (to many to name) for making this new building for our library and exercise room turn out so nice. If you haven't seen it yet stop by and check it out.

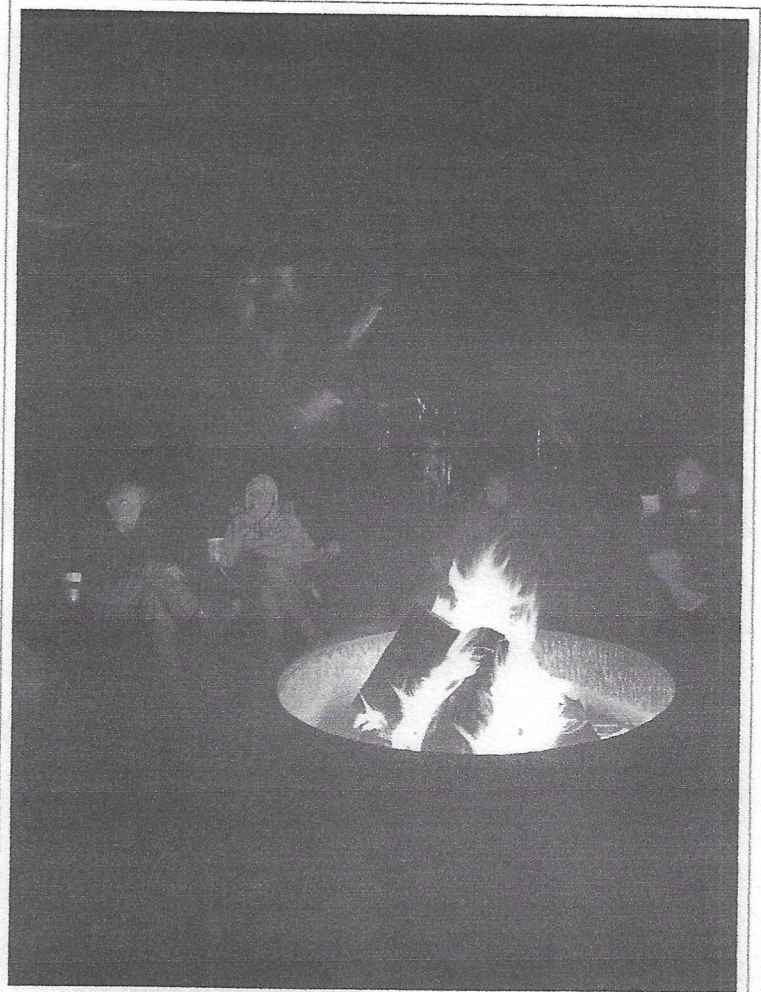

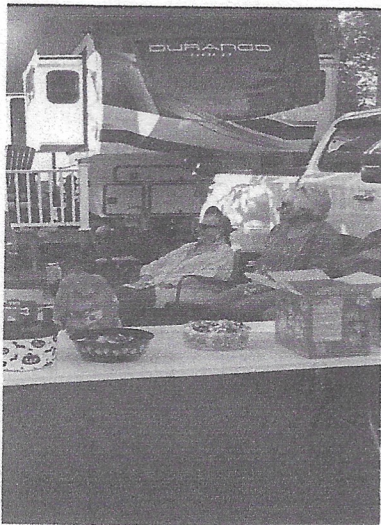

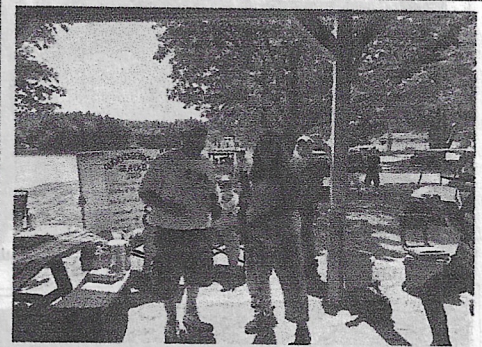
